- Community Service Projects, which is/are Cosmopolitan sponsored and publicized (in Cosmo Topics)
- Conduct a fundraiser or make a contribution to a diabetes project
- Club President or current club office attend immediate past federation convention or be registered prior to judging of awards for the current year International Convention
- Club President or current club office attend immediate past International convention or be registered prior to judging of awards for the current year International Convention
- Submit an article for Cosmo Topics to Headquarters

Competence - Club must meet all the following competence requirements:

- Current in all accounts payable to International
- Publish club bulletin at least monthly with Headquarters on mailing list (may include electronic submissions)
- Club Annual Plan submitted to Headquarters

Cultivation:

• Build a new club OR a net increase in membership as of the end of the Cosmopolitan year on June 15
